

2026 Trash Car & Derby Rules
FWD cars/Mini vans ONLY

Stock (3 cylinder and or 4 Cylinder)
MOD Class V6 (Stock 3 & 4 cylinder class can run both classes)

WINDSHIELDS ALLOWED

- 1) All glass must be removed.
- 2) All break lights and turn lights Removed.
- 3) Doors must be welded or chained shut.
- 4) No reinforcement of frame
- 5) Battery must be secured and tied down
- 6) Minimum one rollbar behind driver seat, bolted 4 nuts and bolts top and bottom. 4-point and Full roll cages encouraged
- 7) Must have working seat belt, driver must have long sleeves, pants, helmet, and gloves.
- 8) Drivers door bar required for Derby. Cars must participate in at least one trash car race to be eligible for Derby.

2026 Chain Race Rules

- 1) ALL pulling cars must be 4 -Cylinder or v6. NO v8 pull cars.
- 2) BOTH cars will have working brakes and back car must have a motor but, NOT running.
- 3) BOTH cars must have good tires. (No Balds or Blems.)
- 4) Drivers doors MUST be welded, chained, or bolted shut.
- 5) Cars will be chained together no less than 4 feet apart. Measured from bumper to bumper. Chains cannot hook to bumper and no pipes on chains
- 6) ALL drivers MUST wear Helmets, Gloves and Neck Braces securely.
- 7) ALL cars are subject to inspection before they can race.
- 8) ALL glass must be removed from all cars except for front windshield.
- 9) ALL cars must have seatbelts with shoulder harnesses or 3 pt. Harness.
- 10) The rear car of the 2-Car chain race team must have the battery and coil wire removed.
- 11) IF a chain breaks, the cars are done and will no longer be scored.
- 12) The main pulling vehicle must be a two wheel drive car.
- 13) You must remain in your vehicle unless an official tells you otherwise.
- 14) second cars engine needs to be off and remain off throughout the event Your team will be disqualified if 2nd car is running at any time through the event.

Drivers Safety:

1. Mandatory- Seat Belts, Long Sleeves, Jeans/Long Pants, Gloves, Shoes and Socks, Full face helmet, and Neck Brace.
2. RECOMENDED – Racing Seat, 5 point safety harness, window net, Fire resistant driving suit, Fire resistant gloves, shoes and socks along with a SA Rated Full Face Helmet, and Neck Brace.
